For more than 20 years, Jack the Bike Man has strengthened the community by donating thousands of bicycles to children, teens and adults who need them most, turning vehicles into freedom, dignity and opportunity. The nonprofit also operates a repair and sales shop from its West Palm Beach headquarters to also support its mission.

From facing the most unexpected and challenging with our warehouse fire earlier this year to rebuilding, regrouping and recommitting to our mission, the nonprofit is emerging with resilience and commitment to supporting those who need our services the most.

In 2025, Jack the Bike Man processed 4,831 bikes, donating, selling, and responsibly scrapping them for parts, recycling nearly 35,000 pounds of materials and significantly reducing landfill waste.

Our bike shop served nearly 2,000 customers, many of whom rely on us for affordable repairs and refurbished bikes.

Through an extensive network of more than 50 Title 1 schools and 30 partners that include social service nonprofits and embedded community program collaborators throughout Palm Beach County, we continue to expand our reach and ability to gift more Jack the Bike Man bicycles to put wheels in motion.

In 2025 alone, 18 new organizations joined our referral network, demonstrating continued growth and expanding demand for transportation access across Palm Beach County.
